The Terminal Building



The new Byron L. Dorgan Terminal, designed by JLG Architects, is a state-of-the-art design that will be Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) registered with sustainable green energy features such as geo-thermal heating and natural light.

The spacious 50,000 square foot airline passenger terminal has two levels connected by escalators and elevators. Outside, the new apron and boarding bridges will be capable of boarding aircraft as large as a Boeing 757.

The Authority's goal was to create a comfortable, convenient traveling environment in a showpiece of pride for the city, region & state.

We designed the building with the traveler in mind.

New features include:

- *Increased passenger waiting area*
- *Enhanced passenger flow indoors & out*
- *Streamlined security processing*
- *Separate levels for ticketing, boarding*
- *Top quality restaurant serving both non-secured & secured sides w/ gift shop & bar*
- *State-of-the-art technology including digital advertising opportunities for local businesses*
- *Natural lighting*
